AEgis Will Assist Anteon On Military Contract

HUNTSVILLE—The Joint Forces
Command (JFCOM) selected the Anteon
team to be the technical support staff for
the Advanced Training Technologies
Laboratory. Huntsville's AEgis Technologies,
which was picked by Anteon to provide
Modeling & Simulation expertise, will provide direct technical support in the area of
live, virtual and constructive simulations.
AEgis will participate in the integration of
multiple simulations into large-scale training federations directly stimulating digital
combat systems.

The mission of the Joint Advance
Training Technology Laboratory is to find,
encourage the development of and validate
technologies prior to introduction into the
LVC training environment at JFCOM in
Suffolk, Virginia. Those validated technologies will become part of the Joint National
Training Capability (JNTC). In this position,
AEgis will enjoy the opportunity to influence
the direction of simulation and its impact
on training initiatives throughout the
Department of Defense.

The Anteon winning contract will be a five-year effort and provides AEgis with an opportunity to expand into a new customer base. As a member of the Anteon team, AEgis will directly support war fighters from all branches of the armed forces as well as support of U.S. allies.

In addition to the Anteon connection, Aegis has launched Xcellon, the new Products Division of AEgis.
